Materials and Supply List

- 50lbs. of waterbased clay*
- 1 life-size armature*
- 3-inch C-Clamps* (2 to secure armature to sculpture stand)
- Clay modeling tools: 3 tools from Reutter tools (TBA)
- Hand towel to wipe clay off of hands and tools. (Cotton, textured is best...bring a few if possible.)
- Water spray bottle
- T-shirt - Jersey cotton to wrap the pieces over night
- A few dry cleaning plastic bags to cover the wet cotton
- A notebook
