Supply and Materials List

July 14–July 18, 2025

Supplies

- Graphite leads or pencils - 6B, 4B, 2B, HB, 2H, 4H and 6H
 - Staedtler Mars 2mm Lead holders, usually about 4 to 6 (Instructor uses 8, but that's not necessary)
- Or–
- Wood pencils in a range from 6B to 6H
 - Mitsubishi Hi-Uni 10H wood pencil
 - 9B Faber Castell Pitt 'Graphite Pure' Woodless Pencil
 - Staedtler 502 lead pointer if using lead holders
 - Xacto blade and sandpaper, if using wood pencils
 - Kneaded eraser
 - Faber Castell eraser pencil, *Perfection 7056* (the pink ones, not the white ones)
 - Stiff Oil painting Bristle brush, approximately 1/4 wide for rubbing in shadows
 - Drawing Board
 - Bulldog Clips or tape to attach paper

If you are working on toned paper, additional supplies:

- General's Charcoal White pencils
- bristle brush, in addition to the one above, and clean

Paper

- Strathmore 500 Bristol Sheets, Plate Surface, 3 or 4 ply paper. It can be bought in single sheets of 23 x 29 inches and cut in half to 14.5 x 23 inches.

–Or–

- Strathmore Toned Grey (or Tan) 18 x 24 inches. (This paper is softer than Bristol and doesn't allow as many corrections.)
