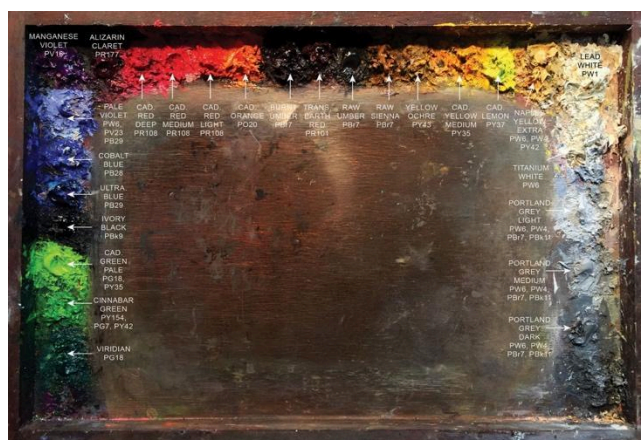
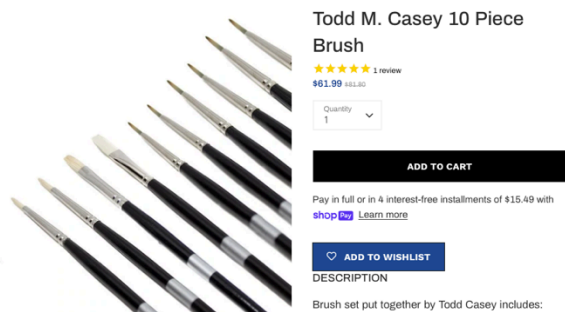
### SURFACES TO PAINT ON:

2 - Canvas or Panels around 6 x 8 inches to 11 x 14 inches prepared for oil painting. Please apply a tone to your canvas so you are not painting on a white ground. A Linen pad such as the Centurion Linen pad is good as well.

### BRUSHES:

Brushes - Different sizes, preferably Synthetics and a few Bristles size 2 through 8. Instructors' brush set specifically for my workshop at [Trekell.com](http://Trekell.com)

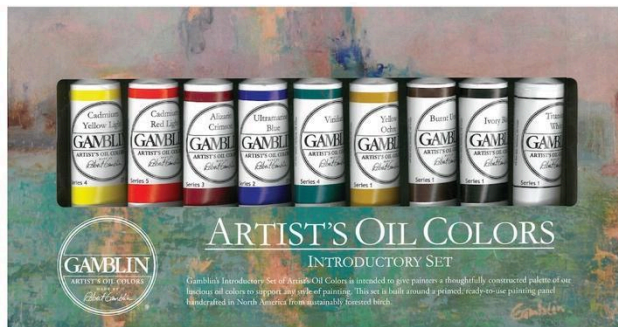
